Day 1 – Saturday OCT 26

Depart Edmonton for Reykjavik, Iceland



Day 2 – Sunday OCT 27

Arrive in Reykjavik, Iceland
Depart from Reykjavik
Arrive in Stockholm, Sweden

Meet your tour guide and bus driver and depart for the hotel. Check in to the hotel. Dinner included at a restaurant or at the hotel. Evening free to explore downtown Stockholm.

Day 3 – Monday OCT 28

Morning guided sightseeing tour of Stockholm including the Vasa Ship Museum.

The afternoon is free for sightseeing, shopping and to have lunch on your own. Meet the bus and depart for the arena. **Exhibition game # 1 vs TBA.** Dinner is included at a restaurant.

Day 4 – Tuesday OCT 29

Morning depart for Drottningholm Palace for a guided tour. The Drottningholm Palace with the Royal Palace, the Court Theatre, the Chinese Pavilion and the beautiful French and English gardens, was the first Swedish site to be placed on the *UNESCO World Heritage* list and is located on the island of Lovön on lake Mälaren.

After the tour, lunch is included at a restaurant. Depart for the arena. **Exhibition game # 2 vs TBA.** Dinner is on your own tonight. In the evening, we will go to the Ice Bar (entry fee and drink included).

Day 5 – Wednesday OCT 30

Morning depart for Uppsalla. Arrive and free time to explore the bustling University city and have lunch on your own. In the afternoon we enjoy a tour of the Vasaborgen or of the Gamla Uppsalla and Museum. Depart for the arena. **Exhibition game # 3 vs TBA.** Dinner is included own tonight. Return to Stockholm by bus.

Day 6 – Thursday OCT 31

Today you have free time in Stockholm to explore the city or maybe go to the Skansen Outdoor Museum, the Tivoli Gröna Lund Amusement Park or the ABBA Museum. (not included). Our centrally located hotel is great for

exploring downtown Stockholm. We will provide you with a list of some interesting things to do. Lunch is on your own today.

Skansen and Grona Lund are next to each other and offer a full day of activities. Skansen is the oldest open-air museum in the world. Skansen is also a zoological park. It is located on the island of Djurgården, a royal park near the centre of Stockholm.

Tivoli Grona Lund is an amusement park in the Swedish capital, Stockholm, which opened in 1883. The park offers typical amusement park attractions, including rollercoasters, rides, a house of fun, a free-fall ride, a haunted house and more.

The nearby ABBA Museum is a great experience for music lovers.



In the afternoon, the bus will pick up passengers downtown and at ABBA/Skansen/Grona Lund and depart for the ferry terminal. The group will board the overnight ferry to Riga, Latvia. Once you find your room we will meet at the buffet restaurant for the included buffet dinner onboard. After dinner enjoy the onboard duty free shopping and live entertainment.

Day 7 – Friday OCT 1

Enjoy breakfast onboard prior to arrival in Riga. Disembark the ferry and meet your bus for a guided sightseeing tour of Riga. After the tour we have free time for lunch on our own. In the afternoon we will check in to the hotel. Depart for the arena. **Exhibition game # 4 vs TBA.** Dinner at a restaurant, evening free.

Day 8 – Saturday OCT 2

After breakfast we will have the morning free to explore Riga. In the afternoon we will depart for Tallinn, Estonia. Along the way we will stop in Parnu, Estonia for lunch on our own. Arrive at the arena in Tallinn and play **Exhibition game # 5 vs TBA.** Dinner is included tonight.

Day 9 – Sunday OCT 3

This morning we check out and meet our local guide for an interesting walking tour of Old Tallinn. After the tour enjoy a lunch at an authentic Medieval Restaurant and then you will have free time to sightsee and shop in Tallinn Old Town. In the late afternoon, meet the group and go to the ferry terminal. Board the ferry and take the 2 hour trip to Helsinki, Finland. Arrive in Helsinki and check in to the hotel. Dinner is on your own.

This morning we depart for a day trip to Turku, Finland. On arrival we meet our local guide for a tour of Turku and Turku Castle. Dinner is included at a restaurant just outside of Turku. After dinner we return to Helsinki.

Day 13 – Thursday OCT 7

Depart for the airport and fly from Helsinki to Reykjavik, Iceland. Arrive in Iceland and meet our bus for a transfer to our hotel. Arrive at the hotel and check in. Lunch is included at the hotel then we will have a short guided tour of Reykjavik. Depart for the arena and play **Exhibition game # 9 vs TBA**. Return to the hotel. Evening free. Dinner is on your own tonight.

Day 14 – Friday OCT 8

Breakfast at the hotel then enjoy the 300 kilometer “Golden Circle Tour” which includes Thingvellir National Park, the Gullfoss waterfall, and the geothermal area in Haukadalur, which contains the geysers Geysir and Strokkur. Depart for the arena and play **Exhibition game # 10 vs TBA**. Return to the hotel. Dinner is included after the game.

Day 15 – Saturday OCT 9

Breakfast at the hotel and check out of the hotel.

Depart for the famous Blue Lagoon for an opportunity to soak in the hot mineral water. You will enjoy the “Comfort” package which includes the entrance fee, a towel, silica mud mask and one free drink.

Depart for the Reykjavik airport to catch your flight home.
