This is a proposed itinerary that is subject to change. The majority of the destinations will not change in the final itinerary.

Day 1 DEPART CANADA

Meet at the airport in Edmonton and depart for Prague, Czech Republic.

Day 2 PRAGUE - Arrival

Arrive in Prague and meet you local guide and driver then transfer to the hotel. Time permitting we will go to downtown Prague for a short free time to wander around the old town and have dinner at a restaurant.

Overnight - Prague Meals - D

Day 3 PRAGUE - CITY TOUR - MEDIEVAL DINNER

After breakfast we transfer to Prague Castle for a guided walking tour of Prague. The tour ends at the Old Town Square after a walk from Prague Castle down to the Lesser Town and across the Charles Bridge to the main city square. Enjoy your free afternoon to have lunch on your own and explore the historic city centre.

In the late afternoon we will return to the hotel to drop off your shopping and to freshen up before we depart for a medieval restaurant near the Old Town Square for an evening of food, drink and entertainment.

Enjoy a free day in Prague today. We will provide you a list of things to see and do.

Day 5 CRYSTAL FACTORY - CESKE KRUMLOV - VIENNA

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. This morning we take a short journey to the town of Nizbor to tour the local crystal factory. Czech crystal is famous for its quality and beauty. We have some time in the factory shop to browse and purchase a souvenir. We stop at a local restaurant for lunch on our own.

We continue to the medieval town of Ceske Krumlov and meet our local expert guide for a walking tour of the UNESCO World Heritage town. During your free time in Ceske Krumlov have time to enjoy dinner on your own, stroll through town or maybe see the torture museum. In the early evening we leave for Vienna and on arrival check in to the hotel.

Day 6 VIENNA - HEURINGER DINNER

Breakfast at the hotel then meet your local guide for a guided bus and walking tour of Vienna including the Hofburg, State Opera House, Imperial Boulevards, the impressive City Hall and stops at Hundertwasser House plus the grounds of the Belvedere Palace and the Summer Palace of Schönbrunn.

After the tour the group will have the remainder of the day free in Vienna to explore the pedestrian area around St. Stephen's Cathedral and the main shopping street, Kärntnerstrasse. You might also like to go to one of the great museums, see the world famous Lipizaner stallion stables or visit a traditional Viennese café to sample local pastries. Another option is to visit the famous Vienna Prater Amusement Park. The entrance fee is free. You can also have lunch at the beer garden restaurant in the Park.

In the late afternoon we return to the hotel to freshen up before departing to a local Heuringer, to drink local wine and enjoy an Austrian dinner.

Day 7 BUDAPEST - HUNGARIAN DINNER - DANUBE EVENING CRUISE

Breakfast at the hotel and depart for the Hungarian capital, Budapest. Arrive in Budapest and meet our local guide for a guided bus and walking tour of Budapest. Enjoy the sights of the twin cities of Buda and Pest including the Fisherman's Bastion, Heroes' Square, the Church of St. Matthias and enjoy panoramic views of the city from Gellert Hill. After the tour and a short free time for lunch on your own we will check in to the hotel. Dinner is included tonight at a Hungarian restaurant. In the evening we will board a boat for a Danube cruise to enjoy the city lights.

Day 8 BUDAPEST - ZAGREB

Breakfast at the hotel and check out of the hotel. This morning we have free time to sightsee, shop and have lunch on our own. Stroll down Vaci street all the way to the Great Market Hall. Maybe go to the Szehcenyi Thermal Baths, one of the largest bath complexes in Europe with 21 pools. The entrance ticket is about 20 Euros.

In the mid afternoon we depart for Zagreb, Croatia. We stop along the way for an included dinner. On arrival in Zagreb, we check in to the hotel.

Day 9 ZAGREB - TRAKOŠĆAN CASTLE

After breakfast, we head to the green hills of Croatian Zagorje region. We will visit the fairytale castle of Trakošćan, the most beautiful castle in Croatia. We will stop for lunch on our own at a restaurant on our way back to Zagreb.

We meet our guide in Zagreb for a tour of the medieval European city including the Upper and Lower town, a vibrant market place, the majestic cathedral, Archbishop's Palace, St. Mark's Church and the Opera House. The evening is free for you to stroll in the historic city center and have dinner on your own.

Day 10 ZAGREB - RASTOKE - PLITVICE LAKES - ZADAR

Breakfast at the hotel and check out of the hotel. We depart towards the picturesque little village of Rastoke, the Millers Village, for a short stop to explore the town.

Afterwards we continue our travel to the forested National Park of Plitvice, the oldest and the biggest national park in Croatia. We will admire the breathtaking waterfalls and lakes of this spectacular UNESCO World Heritage Site during our walking tour of the park. The sixteen lakes of crystal-clear water have many colourful shades of green, grey and blue and are linked by spectacular cascades and waterfalls.

We depart the Plitvice Lakes National Park and stop for lunch on the way to Zadar.

In the afternoon we arrive in Zadar, which was voted the best destination in Europe for 2015. While walking with your guide through the city of Zadar you will see the ancient Forum, the church of St. Donat, St. Anastasia, monuments and palaces, you will learn all about the rich history of this beautiful old town. Tour of the Land Gate and city walls, Square of Five Wells, People's Square and of course the Sea Organ and Greeting to the Sun. Walking along the waterfront with unique sounds of the sea organ will make your experience complete.

After the tour we check in to our hotel and the evening is free for you to explore the town and have dinner on your own.

Day 11 ZADAR - ŠIBENIK - TROGIR - SPLIT

Breakfast at the hotel and check out of the hotel. Before we leave Zadar, we'll spend some of today's morning exploring this old Croatian town with a rich Roman history dating back from the 6 century before Christ.

Around noon we depart for Split with stops in the old Croatian towns Šibenik and Trogir. In Šibenik, we will see a unique monument of European sacral architecture, St. Jacobs Cathedral, which has been listed as a UNESCO World Cultural Monument. The Šibenik Cathedral, adorned with 72 stone heads, is the most significant architectural creation in Croatia from 15th and 16th century. Trogir, an old Croatian town first inhabited by

Greeks and Romans, is famous for its Romanic and gothic old core. We enjoy free time in each town to sightsee on our own and grab a lunch. When we arrive in Split we immediately check in to our hotel. The evening is free to explore the town and have dinner on your own.

Overnight - Split Meals - B

Day 12 SPLIT

After breakfast, we'll take a walk through the „most beautiful city in the world“, how Split is often called by its citizens. We'll visit the Diocletian Palace in the heart of Split, built as a residential palace seventeen hundred years ago by the Roman Emperor Diocletian and also a priceless monument included in the UNESCO list of World Heritage. After the city tour you will have the remainder of the day in Split to enjoy the famous Split waterfront or Riva where you will feel the friendly and cozy atmosphere of this vibrant city.

Day 13 STON - DUBROVNIK

After breakfast, we check out and head towards the South part of Dalmatia, to Dubrovnik, the Pearl of Adriatic. On our way to Dubrovnik we will stop at little town Ston at the start of the Pelješac peninsula. Ston is known for its fortification complex built during the 14th century and that spans 3.5 miles. The Ston area is also known for great seafood, especially oysters, which are grown in the Little Ston bay. Don't miss the opportunity to taste those fruits of the sea. In the evening, we will arrive to Dubrovnik and check into our hotel. The evening is free to explore the town and have dinner on your own.

Overnight - Dubrovnik Meals - B

Day 14 DUBROVNIK

After breakfast we meet our guide for a walking tour of the historic old town of Dubrovnik. This whole day is reserved for exploring and enjoying the Pearl of Adriatic. Its glorious walls, with their fortresses and bastions, offer a unique walk with a view of the magical Elafiti islands. From the Onofrio fountain to the City bell tower, along its main Stradun street, and in many other small and quiet cobblestone streets, every step in this town will be an experience par excellence. After our morning walking tour, the rest of the last day of your tour is yours to explore and enjoy.
