09:40 Arrive in Amsterdam.

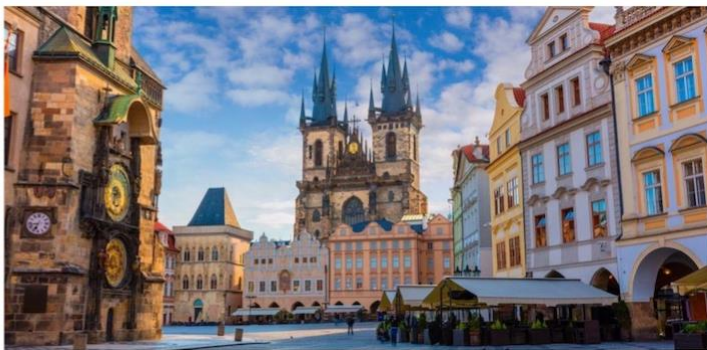
12:05 Depart Amsterdam for Prague on KLM flight KL1355

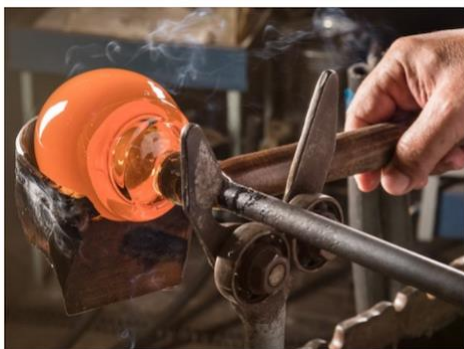
