Players are welcome from other gateways in Canada. Players from other gateways can arrange their own flights and take our no-flight discount or we can request a flight quote from your city.

Destinations in the proposed itinerary include Dusseldorf, Cologne, Wurzburg, Rothenburg, Fussen, Munich, Salzburg, Ceske Budejovice and Prague. The group will enjoy sightseeing tours, and special events throughout the tour in addition to approximately 4 exhibition hockey games and 5 tournament games. The tournament in the German Alps has a division for teams 50+. We will split the team in two and enter two teams in the tournament to ensure plenty of ice time for everyone.

A highlight of the tour is a day at Oktoberfest with reserved tables at the Armbrusschützenszelt beer tent until 4:30 p.m.. Oktoberfest is the world's largest Volksfest, featuring a beer festival and a travelling carnival.

All payments are non-refundable.
